



INQUIRY INTO ALLEGATIONS AGAINST MR. RICHARD MILTON AT THE TAREE RACEMEETING ON
WEDNESDAY 12 JANUARY 2022.

Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission (GWIC) Stewards today concluded an inquiry into the circumstances surrounding allegations of a participant knowingly abetting another person to commit a breach of the rules. After considering evidence given during submissions on January 12, 2022, Mr Milton was asked to attend an inquiry on 26 January 2022. At the hearing on 26 January 2022 Stewards issued the following charge under Rule 86(n) of the GWIC Greyhound Racing Rules which provides;

Rule 86, Greyhound Racing Rules

A person (including an official) shall be guilty of an offence is the person –

(n) knowingly aids, abets, counsels or procures a person to commit a breach of these Rules.

The particulars of the offence were that:

1. On Wednesday 12 January 2022 at the Taree race meeting Mr. Richard Milton knowingly abetted a person to commit a breach of the Greyhound Racing Rules by placing a bet on the behalf of Mr Urquhart, on a race at a meeting in which Mr Urquhart was working in an official capacity.

Mr. Richard Milton provided submissions and pleaded guilty to the charge, and was suspended for a period of 3 months, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to the condition that he does not breach this Rule or a similar Rule.
