

## GREYHOUND WELFARE & INTEGRITY COMMISSION DISCIPLINARY ACTION DECISION

Date of decision: Sunday 18 August 2024

**Decision-makers:** Acting Chief Steward Dean Degan and Steward Paul Marks

Name of relevant person: Scott Slater

**Rule no.:** R165(c)(ii)

Charge(s): Charge – 165(c)(iii)

Mr. Slater did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, constitutes an offence by engaging in an activity which

was offensive and insulting.

Plea: Guilty

**Disciplinary action taken:** To issue a disqualification of 6 months

With the penalty backdated to the commencement of the existing interim suspension and therefore expiring 2 February 2025.

## **DECISION:**

- 1. Mr. Slater was, at all relevant times, a registered Public Trainer with the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission.
- 2. On Sunday 28 July 2024, Mr. Slater attended the Broken Hill Greyhound Club.
- 3. During the meeting Mr. Slater became involved in a verbal altercation with a security guard employed by the club, in which Mr. Slater engaged in offensive and insulting language which resulted in his removal from the club.
- 4. On Wednesday 7 August 2024 Mr Slater was issued with a notice of charge and proposed disciplinary action ("Notice"). The Notice issued a charge against him for breach of the following Greyhound Racing Rule:

## Charge - Rule 165(c)(iii), Rules

An offence is committed if a person (including an official):

- - -

- (c) engages in contemptuous, unseemly, improper, insulting, or offensive conduct or behaviour in any manner or form towards, or in relation to:
  - iii. A Club, or an officer, employee or member of a Club
- 5. The Notice proposed a penalty of a 9-month disqualification and invited Mr Slater to attend a hearing on Sunday 19 August 2024 and to enter a plea and make submissions in relation to the charge and proposed penalty.
- 6. At the hearing conducted via Microsoft Teams on Sunday 19 August 2024, Mr Slater;
  - Entered a plea of guilty; and
  - Made verbal submissions
- 7. Following considering of Mr Slater's plea and submissions, the decision-makers found the charge proven and took the following disciplinary action against him:

**Charge** – To issue a disqualification of 6 months

With the penalty backdated to the commencement of the existing interim suspension and therefore expiring 2 February 2025.

- 8. In taking this disciplinary action, the decision-makers considered all evidence, including:
  - Mr. Slater's Guilty plea
  - Mr. Slater's 37-year registration history with no prior penalties for any like offences.
  - GWIC penalty precedents; and
  - Principles of specific and general deterrence and what message is sent to the industry in respect to such conduct.
