

GREYHOUND WELFARE & INTEGRITY COMMISSION DISCIPLINARY ACTION DECISION

Date of decision: Tuesday 23 July 2024

Decision-makers: Acting Chief Steward Dean Degan and Steward Craig Easey

Name of relevant person: Simone Loader

Rule no.: R156(o)

Charge(s): Charge – R156(o)

Miss Loader did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, constitutes an offence, by making a statement to an officer of the Controlling Body when it was known to be false.

Plea: Guilty

Disciplinary action taken: Five Month Disqualification with the period of disqualification

commencing Saturday 27 July 2024 and expiring 27 December

2024.

DECISION:

- 1. Miss Loader was, at all relevant times, a registered Attendant with the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission.
- 2. On Thursday 4 July 2024 Miss Loader was issued with a notice of charge and proposed disciplinary action ("Notice") following the Commission becoming aware that Miss Loader had knowingly made a false statement in an interview with an officer of the Controlling Body. The Notice issued a charge against her for breach of the following Greyhound Racing Rule:

Rule 156(o)

An offence is committed if a person (including an official)

- (o) makes or publishes any statement known by the person to be false where the publication is to:
- i. A member of a Controlling Body;
- ii. An officer of a Controlling Body;
- iii. An employee of a Controlling Body; or
- iv. An officiating veterinarian or official in the course of them performing their functions.

3. The Notice invited Miss Loader to attend a hearing on Tuesday 23 July 2024 and to enter a plea and make submissions in relation to the charge and proposed penalty.

Charge (Rule 156(o)) - To issue a disqualification of nine months

- 4. On Monday 22 July 2024 Miss Loader provided written submissions to decision makers and, at the hearing conducted via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday 23 July 2024, Miss Loader:
 - Entered a plea of guilty to the Charge; and
 - Made verbal submissions.
- 5. Following consideration of Miss Loader's plea and submissions, the decision-makers found the charges proven and determined to impose the following disciplinary action upon her:

Charge (Rule 156(o)) - Five Month Disqualification, with the period of disqualification commencing Saturday 27 July 2024 and expiring 27 December 2024.

- 6. In taking this disciplinary action, the decision-makers considered all evidence, including:
 - Miss Loader's guilty plea;
 - Miss. Loader's written submission and verbal submissions made at the hearing; and
 - Miss. Loader's seven-year registration history, with no prior penalties.
