### How to register your litter of pups

Are you a breeder and ready to get your litter registration off and racing? Here are the steps to follow on eTrac to make sure you're on the right track.

Complete a whelping notice and litter registration. Return it to GWIC within 14 days of the whelp/due date.

Submit record of C3 vaccination at 6-8 weeks.

Submit record of C5 vaccination at 10-16 weeks.

GWIC will arrange microchipping/ear tattooing of the litter between 12-16 weeks. GWIC completes a litter identification form.

**GWIC** registers the litter.

Litters can not be reigstered until those steps are completed. If you require any assistance contact us on 13 49 42 (13 GWIC).

Location where you paid



## Help your dog chill out after racing

Given the warm summer weather, it is important to cool your greyhound down post-race. Here are some simple ways to help them chill out:

**Provide** arevhounds with water



Immerse your greyhound in a cool pool



Hose your greyhound's feet, chest, back and groin



Remove excess water with a towel
