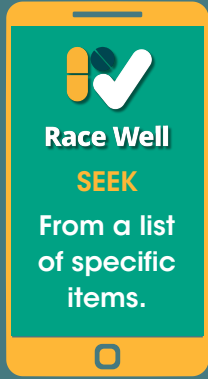
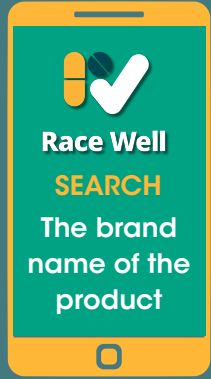

Termination of ear tattooing



Greyhounds Australasia has determined that by 1 July 2024 ear tattooing of registered greyhounds will cease nationwide. Microchipping will now act as the primary method of identification.



This comes as part of a national move to drive the best possible greyhound welfare standards.

Part 9: Rehoming Greyhounds as Companion Animals

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Where a greyhound owner does not wish to retain a greyhound, the owner must ensure, as far as reasonably possible, that the greyhound is prepared for rehoming as a companion animal.
