Joined a mate? Time to syndicate

If you are involved in the ownership of a greyhound, then you are required to register as a Private Syndicate with the Commission.

Syndicates enable owners and managers to fund the cost of training and caring for a greyhound, while for syndicate members it is a way to get involved in the sport without needing to be a registered participant.

Code of Practice

Part 8: Training, trialling and racing



- Greyhounds shall only participate in trials or races that are conducted at a registered trial track or licensed racecourse.
 - No greyhound under the age of 16 months shall be nominated for a race, and no greyhound under the age of 12 months shall participate in a trial.

TO OTV OR NOT TO OTV - IS THAT YOUR QUESTION?

If you are seeking an alteration to a stand down period applied by a GWIC On Track Veterinarian (OTV), the process to follow depends on the reason for scratching.



Scratched due to seasonal condition, illness or condition: Obtain a certificate from your veterinarian stating your greyhound is fit to start at time of the examination.



Scratched due to fleas: Either your veterinarian or an OTV can re-examine the greyhound.



Scratched due to injury: A trainer can apply to stewards to have an OTV re-examine their greyhound.
