- GIPAC identified GAP as a concern
  - Steve reported that this, the impact on breeding and underutilisation rate, was top of mind at the recent GRNSW Board meeting. Rehoming was also discussed.

### 6. Other business

- Desexing and the misperception that a desexed greyhound is not permitted to race
  - Noted included on the GRNSW rehoming assistance form
  - o GWIC confirmed that if a veterinarian thinks there is no reason why a greyhound shouldn't race, then the greyhound can race.
  - A stand down period to allow for recovery post surgery applies.
  - The 30 day wind down policy is recommended, but not mandatory
  - o GWIC will be distributing some communications to clarify this issue
- GWIC reported:
  - o Revenue is down

- Race Industry Reduction pilots are doing well; data to be shared at the upcoming Industry Summit
- o GRNSW trialling soft sand at the Taree track
- 1 euthanasia this year at Dubbo, following a collision. 13 in total this financial year which compares to 40 in the past. Groups opposing greyhound racing are now looking at serious injuries and prohibited substances
- Race Well (proof of substance) App Wade now looking at a March/April launch. Wade to attend next meeting to talk about the App.
