### 2. Adoption of minutes of previous meeting

The minutes from the meeting held on 16 February 2024 were formally adopted by the participants.

#### 3. Outstanding action items

- Compile a list of tracks with shade sails and cool pools
  - Wade to discuss with Tony Kuipers who is looking into research around use of cool pools and contamination
- List of transporters 3 recommendations only have been received
  - Martin will provide more next meeting
  - o Glen suggests Ray Brittain from Melbourne (Canine Transport Services)
- e-Trac functionality and notification of swab results in progress
- Issue of desexing and racing and GRNSW's Rehoming Assistance Form
  - Kristy has discussed with GRNSW issue of under what circumstances will cost of desexing be covered by HAS
  - o GWIC aims to distribute some communications to clarify the issues.
  - Noted that veterinarians in Victoria impose a 28 day standdown period post desexing
- Tracking of interstate greyhounds racing in NSW
  - Will increase transparency around who is training; general public want to know. GWIC need to know to enable sampling
  - General agreement that a period needs to be set; what is fair and reasonable. In horses a
    maximum of 1 month is allowed in caretaker mode.
  - Generally agreed that 1 month is adequate.

#### Action:

- 1. GWIC to issue comms to clarify the issues around desexing
- 2. Wade to arrange for GWIC Policy Team to develop a paper on interstate greyhounds racing in NSW.

#### 4. Feedback in relation to GWIC
