Registration types



All industry participants must be registered with the Commission and comply with the conditions of their registration.

Non-compliance can result in conditions or penalties and the Commission can decide to refuse, suspend or cancel a registration if deemed in the best interests of the greyhound racing industry.

HOW TO APPLY

Completed applications must include the following requirements:

- National Police Check. GWIC will apply for this on your behalf, you will then receive an email from NSW Police with instructions on how to complete.
- Colour passport style photograph.
- Copy of other racing body registration (if required).
- Fee payment (NPC included in fee).
- Applications for breeder, trainer and attendant registrations include a Registration Knowledge Test.

Please note that there may be additional requirements dependent on the registration type.
