



Standards of dress



To promote the image of greyhound racing in NSW, the Greyhound Welfare & Integrity Commission has developed a standard of dress that should be familiar to most participants.



▶▶▶▶▶ TAB TRACKS

A neat and tidy appearance is requested for all broadcast races. The following dress code applies to trainers and handlers participating in greyhound race meetings at NSW TAB tracks. Catchers should also be dressed neatly eg. Jeans and a collared shirt.

The Commission's stewards may penalise participants at their discretion for failing to comply with the standard of dress.

Black or navy pants

Black enclosed shoes with dark socks (no joggers, thongs, sandals or high heels).

No leggings, tracksuit pants, cargo pants or casual shorts.

Gumboots may be worn with prior stewards approval.

Black or navy tailored dress shorts.

Black or navy jacket.

Black or navy skirt (knee length).

Plain black beanie.

GRNSW issued polo shirt (unless exempt).

Cap or wide brimmed hat (no offensive logos).

▶▶▶▶▶ NON-TAB TRACKS

Non-TAB tracks should formalise a dress code at their discretion and encourage all participants to ensure they have a neat and tidy appearance.

No casual shorts or open footwear permitted.
