



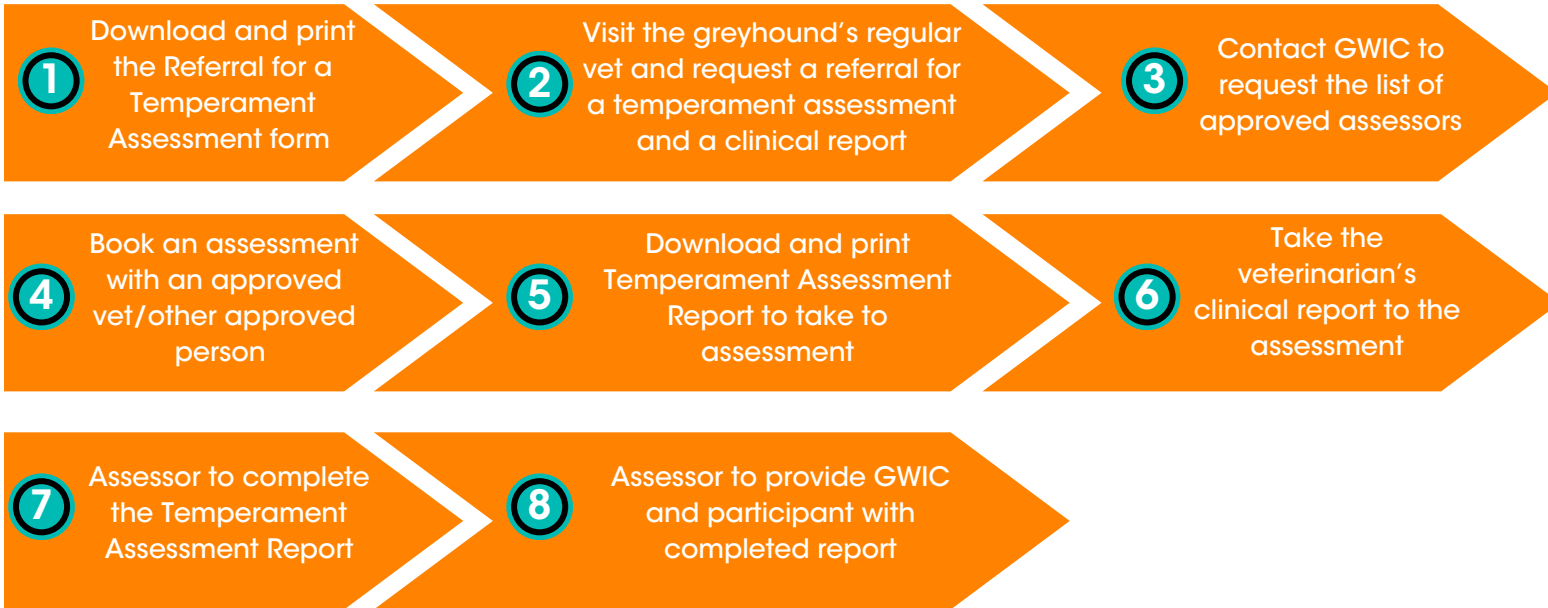
# Greyhound Rehoming Policy



During the rehoming process a temperament assessment may be required if there are concerns the greyhound may not be suitable for rehoming due to behavioural issues. Temperament assessments must be completed by a veterinarian practitioner or other person approved by GWIC.

## Advising GWIC of the assessment outcome

If the greyhound has been deemed unsuitable for rehoming the greyhound can then be euthanased by a veterinarian. Once this has been done, the participant must submit the following to GWIC:
