MEMO ON MUZZLES: A change has been made to the mandatory requirements in regard to muzzles when racing.

Plastic muzzles are no longer permitted for racing. This means all racing muzzles must now be made from wire. Not only are wire muzzles more robust, they provide superior visibility in photo finishes.
