	Mr Bootsma has acted improperly, by failing to check-in or provide end of life or retirement notifications his greyhounds.

DECISION	

DECISION

- 1. Mr Bootsma was at all relevant times, a registered Owner Trainer and Breeder Whelper with the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission.
- 2. At all material times the greyhound/s the subject of the charges were registered in Mr Bootsma's ownership.
- 3. On Monday 11 November 2024, following an investigation by the Commission, a Notice of Charge was issued to Mr Bootsma. The Notice issued two charges under the Greyhound Racing Rules alleging a breach of the following:

Charge 1: Rule 156(f)(ii)

156 General offences

An offence is committed if a person (including an official):

(f) has, in relation to a greyhound or greyhound racing, done something, or omitted to do something, which, in the opinion of a Controlling Body or the Stewards:

(i) is corrupt, fraudulent, or dishonest;

(ii) constitutes misconduct or is negligent or improper;

Charge 2: Rule 156(h) 156 General offences

An offence is committed if a person (including an official):

- (h) disobeys or fails to comply with a lawful order of a Controlling Body, the Stewards, or another person authorised by a Controlling Body with official duties in relation to greyhound racing;
- 4. The Notice invited Mr Bootsma to attend a hearing and make submissions in relation to the charges.
- 5. Mr Bootsma failed to attend the hearing or make submissions in relation to the charges by Friday 22 November 2024
- 6. The decision makers found the charges proven and issued Mr Bootsma with a Notice of Proposed Penalty on Monday 25 November 2024, which proposed the following penalties and invited Mr Bootsma to make submissions in response:

Charge 1 - To disqualify Mr Bootsma until such time his greyhounds are checked-in or the relevant end of life or retirement notifications are completed and submitted.

Charge 2 - To disqualify Mr Bootsma until such time his greyhounds are checked-in or the relevant end of life or retirement notifications are completed and submitted.

7. Mr Bootsma failed to respond and make submissions by Monday 02 December 2024. Accordingly, the decision makers imposed the following penalties:

Charge 1 - To disqualify Mr Bootsma until such time his greyhounds are checked-in or the relevant end of life or retirement notifications are completed and submitted.

Charge 2 - To disqualify Mr Bootsma until such time his greyhounds are checked-in or the relevant end of life or retirement notifications are completed and submitted.

8. The Commission's enquiries into the locations of these greyhounds remain ongoing.
