You just need a group of two or more friends, with one registered as the syndicate manager to act on behalf of members.

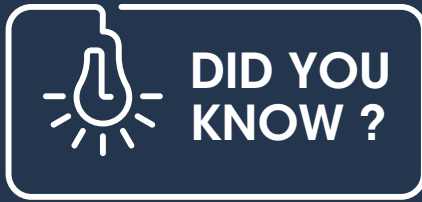

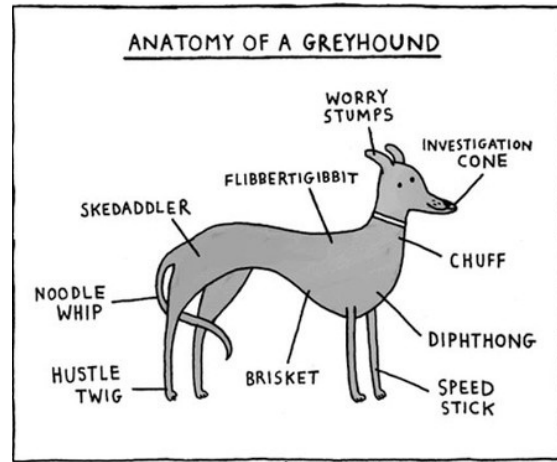
### Leptospirosis cases confirmed in NSW

## CODE OF PRACTICE

### Greyhound kennel sizes - 3.5sqm

Part 5 of the Greyhound Welfare Code of Practice states all new kennels must be 3.5sqm.

Existing kennels have until 31 December 2030 to comply, but must be at least 3sqm in the meantime.



## FROM THE STEWARDS' ROOM

A reminder that Local Rule 166A places additional restrictions on lay betting or betting to lose.

It is an offence to:

- bet on your own greyhound in a race to lose, or have someone else do so on your behalf
- bet on another greyhound in the same race, or have someone else do so on your behalf
- receive the proceeds from lay betting.
