HOW TO....

Apply for a duplicate ID card

If you have lost, damaged or had your participant or greyhound identification card stolen, you can apply for a replacement:

- Online at www.gwic.nsw.gov.au/registration/greyhound-applications-andnotifications/lost,-stolen-or-damaged-id-cards
- By completing a Duplicate Identification Card application form.

The fee for a duplicate identification card is \$15. You may be eligible for a free replacement if your card has been lost or stolen.
