HOW TO....

Check-in your greyhound

1. You will receive an SMS or email when your greyhound/s are due for a check-in.
2. Visit the eTrac map on the GWIC website to find your nearest check-in location and make an appointment.
3. Attend your check-in appointment with your greyhound/s. It takes 30 seconds to scan and check-in each greyhound and information is updated in the eTrac system immediately.

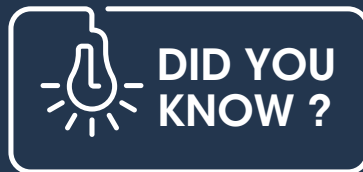
Dental health



Periodontal disease, also known as tooth and gum disease, is very common in dogs.

You can prevent periodontitis disease by providing your greyhound with dental chews or raw meaty bones, brushing teeth and getting your greyhound's teeth checked by a vet.

GWIC will be conducting a pilot of On-Track Veterinarians attending trials in May 2023.

Analysis of data suggested that some serious injuries are attributed to a greyhound having a pre-existing injury. The Race Injury Reduction Summit identified that by OTVs recording injuries that occur at a trial, it may reduce serious injuries on race day.

CODE OF PRACTICE Transporting greyhounds

Part Six of the Greyhound Welfare Code of Practice requires greyhounds to be transported in way that does not cause injury or stress.

Compartments and cages must be weatherproof, well ventilated and provide enough room for the greyhound to sit, stand and lie down.

The below local rules will be introduced from the 1 May 2023:

- LR 21A Causing undue harm to a greyhound
- LR 34A Accounting for a greyhound's whereabouts
- LR 34B Request to present a greyhound
- LR 55 Breeder registration
- LR 55A Location of pregnant dams
- LR 64A Registration of a litter
- LR 178D Registration restrictions - Suspensions
- LR 178F Registration restrictions - DQs
- LR 182 Participants facing criminal charges
