

GREYHOUND WELFARE & INTEGRITY COMMISSION DISCIPLINARY ACTION DECISION

Date of decision: Tuesday 21 May 2024

Decision-makers: Senior Steward Kevin Adams and Steward Sam Woolaston

Name of relevant person: Anthony Turner

Rule no.: R156(f)(ii)

Charge(s): Charge - 156(f)(ii)

Mr. Turner did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, constitutes an offence by engaging in an activity which

constitutes misconduct.

Plea: Not Guilty

Disciplinary action taken: To issue a disqualification of 12 months

With the penalty to commence 22 May 2024 and expiring 22 May 2025.

DECISION:

- 1. Mr. Turner was, at all relevant times, a registered Owner Trainer with the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission.
- 2. On Monday 22 April 2024, Mr. Turner attended the Maitland Greyhound Club.
- 3. In the car park adjoining the club Mr. Turner became involved in a verbal and physical altercation with another participant, in which the participant was punched several times by Mr. Turner.
- 4. On Monday 13 May 2024 Mr Turner was issued with a notice of charge and proposed disciplinary action ("**Notice**"). The Notice issued a charge against him for breach of the following Greyhound Racing Rule:

Charge - Rule 156(f)(ii), Rules

An offence is committed if a person (including an official):

- f) has, in relation to a greyhound or greyhound racing done something, or omitted to do something, which in the opinion of a controlling body or stewards:
- (ii) constitutes misconduct or is negligent or improper
- 5. The Notice proposed a penalty of an 18 month disqualification and invited Mr Turner to attend a hearing on Tuesday 22 May 2024 and to enter a plea and make submissions in relation to the charge and proposed penalty.
- 6. At the hearing conducted at the Gardens Greyhound Club on Tuesday 22 May 2024, Mr Turner;
 - · Entered a plea of not guilty; and
 - Made verbal submissions
- 7. Following considering of Mr Turner's plea and submissions, the decision-makers found the charge proven and took the following disciplinary action against him:

Charge – To issue a disqualification of 12 months

With the penalty to commence 22 May 2024 and expiring 22 May 2025.

- 8. In taking this disciplinary action, the decision-makers considered all evidence, including:
 - Mr. Turner's Not Guilty plea
 - Mr. Turner's 25-year registration history with no prior penalties for any like offences.
 - Purpose of issuing penalties as a protective measure for the image and interests of the greyhound racing industry
 - Principles of specific and general deterrence and what message is sent to the industry in respect to such conduct.
